Session Topics

Session	Description
Introduction	Welcome. The how and why of the video curriculum.
Worldview & Work Culture	Everyone has a worldview and every company has a culture. Will you be able to engage with those who have a different one? Why is developing cross-cultural competence important?
Character, Competency & Connection: Essential. Non-negotiable.	Want to make an impact? Strengthen your ability to share about Jesus? Be successful in your career and in leading? Excellence in competency, character and connection are essential.
Worship & Occupation	Is vocational ministry occupation the best calling for us? Is worshiping God through prayer, dance, and song the only way to worship? The basis for these questions- and corresponding answers- will be explored. What you discover may prove liberating!
Reflect God's Image: Man & Work	How is man like God, and what has God showed us about Himself regarding work? Learn about the different occupations that reflect God's image (you're probably pursuing one of them), and how to invite God into your work day.
Reflect God's Image: Why Work?	We go deeper into the questions of how is man like God, His first commission to man, His expectation of us as workers, five reasons for work, and the New Testament profile of a good employee.
Kingdom Perspective	Is getting saved the ends or the means? What does God expect of us after we make our decision to follow him? What does it mean to live an integrated life and how should that connect to our work?
Calling & Career	What are God's thoughts about my vocational interests? What is calling and how would it affect my career journey? Personal Vision Statement's value to guiding life choices.
Ethics- A Biblical Perspective	How will I handle unethical situations at work? Tools to guide you.
Sharing Christ @ Work: Prayer Foundations	The role of prayer in sharing our faith in our workplace context.
Sharing Christ @ Work: Bridge Building	Building relationships at work: the essentials for connecting with co-workers.
Sharing Christ @ Work: In Word & Deed	Sharing about Jesus. Learn practical tools to initiate spiritual conversation in natural ways.
Finances & the Christian Young Professional	"My first real job. I'm rich!...or not." Biblical Stewardship and generosity. How to increase your impact and make a difference!
Justice in the City	What are God's thoughts on issues of justice for the marginalized? What are big picture strategies for pursuing justice in a biblical manner? How do we actually work to address social issues God cares about? How do we help "seek the peace and prosperity of the city," as described by the prophet Jeremiah? What criteria should we consider before joining a cause?
Christians & Cultural Influence	What should be the role of a Christian in the world? Should they intentionally seek to influence their culture? If so, how?
Finding & Being Community	Finding a church; a mentor; friends. What's a healthy community?
Feature Video: Faith @ Work in the World	Interviews from Christians in the global marketplace. What's it like to walk out their faith in their context? Towards a globally savvy change agent.
